### Club Policies:

Each participant is expected to adhere to all club rules and policies that have been set by the Golf professional and Course Superintendent on the date of the tournament.

**Participants and volunteers need to follow the required dress code.** Proper golf attire is to be worn at all times while on the course, driving range, and practice areas. For men, proper attire is a collared golf shirt with slacks, golf shorts or neat jeans.\* Golf shorts must be Bermuda length. Swimsuits, running shorts, tennis shorts, sweatpants or cut-offs are not acceptable attire. For women, proper attire is a golf shirt or golf tee shirt, golf shorts, skirts, skorts, capris, slacks or neat jeans.\* Jogging suits, swimsuits, running shorts, short shorts, halter tops, tennis shorts or tennis dresses are not acceptable. Shoes designed specifically for golf must be worn at all times. Shoes with metal spikes are not permitted. Hats or visors must be worn with the bill facing forward. (\*Jeans must have NO holes, stains, letters or labels.)

Appropriate Pace of Play is required and will be monitored by the club staff. The expectation is that a round of golf should take no more than 4 ½ hours based upon the course layout and level of difficulty.

Proper care of the course is required through repair of ball marks, replacement of divots and/or sand mix, the adherence to cart traffic signage and policy and general course etiquette.

Homeowner yards are considered Out of Bounds and are marked as such. The yards are private property and should be respected as such and trespassing should be avoided.
