OPEN EBOOKS

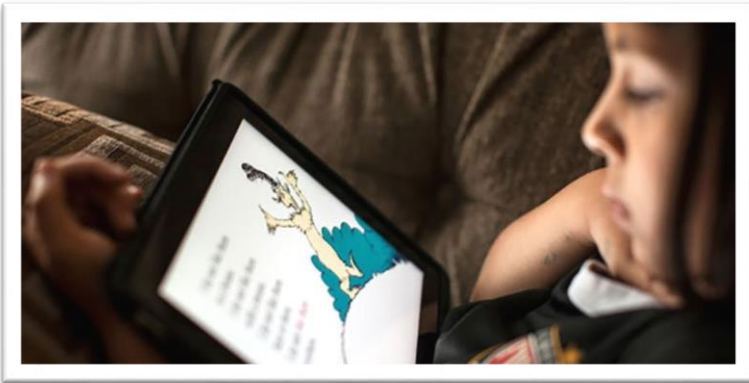

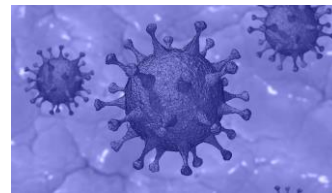
