Some of these questions are answered with more detail on the NMDOH website. For example, here is one frequently asked question and the answer:

What will it cost to get a COVID-19 vaccine? Is it free? What if I don't have health insurance?

The vaccine is free to all people. Vaccination providers will be able to charge an administration fee that is reimbursed by the patient's public or private insurance company or, for uninsured patients, by the federal Health Resources and Services Administration's (HRSA) Provider Relief Fund. The federal government is requiring vaccine providers to administer vaccine to people regardless of their insurance status or immigration status. And they must administer without charging them for the vaccine.

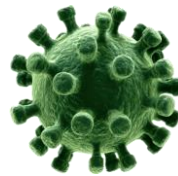
TOP HOWLERS
