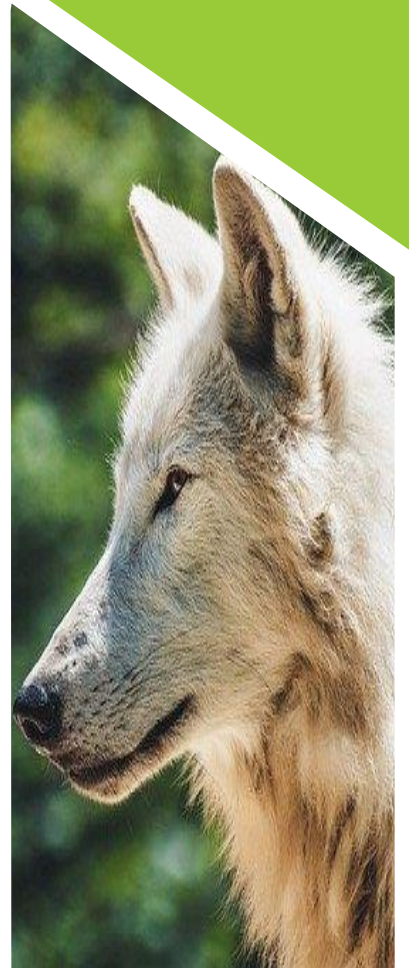

ECRA STUDENT DAILY COVID-19 QUESTIONNAIRE

(if you choose in-person learning)



Each day before sending your child to school, please review the following questions regarding your child's health.

If you answer yes to any of the questions:

Please do not send your child to school. Contact a medical provider or call the COVID Hotline at 855-600-3453, then call the health office at ECRA.

Questions for ECRA Students Before They Go to School

1. Does your child currently have a temperature of over 100.4 degrees?
2. In the past 24 hours, has your child experienced:
 - Sore throat, runny nose, congestion
 - New frequent, dry cough (for students with documented chronic allergies/asthma, a change in baseline cough)
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Diarrhea, vomiting
 - Loss of taste or smell
 - New onset of headache
 - Fatigue or muscle or body aches
3. Has your child recently been in close contact with anyone who has exhibited any of these symptoms?
4. Has your child recently been in contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19?

Reviewing these questions daily and making good decisions can help us prevent the spread of COVID-19.

ELEMENTARY FIELD DAY

Field Day for elementary students will be held on June 17th. Onsite students will be able to participate in socially distanced activities and remote students



will have a virtual event. A flyer with more information will be available soon.

SCHOOL DEVICE RETURN

Families of students that are remote will be contacted about returning school devices, cords, and headphones between June 21st and 23rd. Students will also receive a book to keep for summer reading at that time. Onsite students will leave their devices at the school on their last day. More information will be available soon.
