
# In Recognition of Mr. Jim Nessle



Dear ECRA Families,

There have been some concerns regarding parking lot safety. Here are some precautions to keep in mind during drop off and pick up times.

#### DROP OFF:

- Students can only be dropped off on the inside lane closest to the building. Please be sure they are exiting the car on the building side.
- The outside lane will be for drive through passing only. Do not drop off in this lane.
- There will be a sign clearly identifying which lane is for drop off and which is for passing.
- Families will need to enter through Clinton in order to get in the proper lane
- There is a fence in between parking spaces and the drop off/pick up/drive through lanes to avoid drivers darting in and out which puts pedestrians at risk.
- Please do not drive along the outside of the fence to drop off students (east side), This is part of the parking area and dangerous for students using the crosswalk.
- Pedestrians need to use crosswalks to get to the building.
- Please keep the crosswalks clear in order to keep them accessible to pedestrians
- The speed limit is 5 mph and please stop for pedestrians.
- Please watch staff for stop and slow signs and follow their directions.
- Do not park and exit your vehicle while in these lanes. Please use the parking lot.
- Please stay off your cell phone to help keep everyone safe.
- Students should not enter the parking lot without a parent. Please either use the drive through lane or come to the front of the building and pick up your child from their teacher.

#### PICK UP:

- K-1 students will be picked up on Clinton on the sidewalk next to the elementary playground
- Grades 2-12 will use the front of the building for student pick up
- Please follow all the same safety guidelines named above in the drop off section.
