What is Title I?

Title I is the largest federal aid program for schools in the United States. Title I provides federal funds to schools with a high percentage of low-income students. These funds provide extra educational resources to help students achieve and succeed regardless of any disadvantages they are experiencing through no fault of their own.

APS, Title I provides the coordination, technical assistance, and other support necessary to assist and build the capacity of all participating schools in planning and implementing effective family involvement activities to improve student academic achievement and school performance. (ESSA Section 1116(b)(2)

What does this mean? Title I provides extra educational resources to schools with a high number of children experiencing poverty.

Additionally, Title I schools must provide opportunities for families to be engaged in their students' education. Parents and families are encouraged to be involved with their schools Title I program and learn how Title I funds are spent.
